

Ashanti Region Tracking Poll 2024 Presidential Elections 2nd September 2024

Executive Summary

- A regional tracking poll conducted in the Ashanti region since August 2nd 2024 shows both John Dramani Mahama (JDM) and Dr Mahamudu Bawumia (DMB) surging in the region compared to the previous poll as Alan Kwadwo Kyeremanten fades.
- □Using all voters model, JDM, 26%, DMB, 64%, AKK, 3%, NKB, 1%, others, 1% and I will not vote, 5%. However, using the "committed likely voter's model, JDM, 28%, DMB, 67%, AKK, 3%, NKB, 1% other, 1%.
- □The data shows that AKK lost support among floating voters in the region which led to a drop of 5.7% compared to the previous poll. The data also shows that 71% of the 5.7% of the votes went to John Mahama while 29% went to Dr Bawumia.
- □However, in the runoff scenario, the poll shows that 42% of voters who remained loyal to Alan will vote DMB, 27% are undecided and 31% will not vote.

Executive Summary

The poll also shows that the economic situation has greater influence on voters' decision, 63%, followed by past performance of the parties, 50%, manifestoes, 39%, credibility of the candidates, 36% and other reasons, 7%.


□On the direction of the country, the poll shows majority of voters in the region believe Ghana is headed in the wrong direction as 50% believe the country is headed in the wrong direction, 47% believe it is headed in the right direction while 3% have no opinion.

Economy, jobs and education are the top three issues for voters with 71%, 71% and 50% of the mentions being the top items for voters.


Methodology and Approach:

- □Sample size, 1348, confidence level: 95% and Margin of Error: 2.54%
- Demographic analysis of the results would carry higher margin of error than the poll's average.
- The Electoral Commission's 2024 voters register was used as sample frame.
- □ The presidential poll is based using "All Voters", and "Committed Voters" models.
- The poll is a tracking poll carried in 14 constituencies in the region. The samples were drawn from the same constituencies and electoral areas polled in July 2024.
- Computer Assisted Personal Interviews (CAPI) were conducted between 28th 30th August.



























How Likely will Dr Mathew Opoku Prempeh's nomination influence you to vote for NPP in December 2024?




Which of the following have greater influence how you will vote?







Which of the following candidates do you believe understands and cares for people like you?




Voters' Level of Support for the manifestoes










