## RE: AGREEMENT ON LOC REGIME ENFORCEMENT FOR FREE ZONE COMPANIES

We refer to a letter from the Vice President's Secretariat of the Office of the President dated 4<sup>th</sup> March 2024 (copy attached), conveying conclusions reached after two (2) meetings held under the auspices of His Excellency the Vice President to discuss the application of the Letter of Commitment (LoC) to Free Zones Enterprises (FZEs).

In line with the conclusions reached, the Bank of Gnana (BoG) will adopt the following procedures:

- 1. The LoC shall continue to be the main document required to accompany all exports from Ghana.
- 2. FZEs seeking to export goods shall be required to generate the LoC from the Integrated Customs and Management System (ICUMS).
- 3. In the process of generating the LoC, FZEs shall chose the option "NO" in the field tagged "Would Export Proceeds be repatriated" to clearly indicate that repatriation of export proceeds is not mandatory.
- 4. Per the existing operational procedures, all LoCs for which repatriation of export proceeds are not required are instantly referred to the BoG for approval.
- 5. The BoG shall immediately grant approval to LoCs for FZEs referred to the Bank.
- 6. The Free Zones Board would be required to provide the current list of all FZEs and inform the Bank as soon as a new FZE is approved or an existing FZE ceases to be a member.

7. Existing LoCs generated by FZEs which require repatriation of export proceeds may be submitted to the BoG by the respective FZE for the status to be amended.

Please note that the above arrangement supersedes the dispensation given to the Blue Sky products (Ghana) Limited per our letter dated 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2024 and copied to your good self.

#### AGREEMENT ON LOC REGIME ENFORCEMENT FOR FREE ZONE COMPANIES

I am writing to summarize the outcomes from recent discussions regarding the Letter of Commitment (LOC) regime, specifically its application to Free Zones Companies. These discussions, prompted by a request from Blue Skies Limited, took place on February 23rd and 26th, 2024, under the auspices of the Vice President's Office.

- 2. The key stakeholders included the Bank of Ghana, Ghana Revenue Authority, Ministry of Finance, Free Zones Authority, and the Association of Free Zone Entities. Outlined below are the agreed-upon measures:
  - a. The Bank of Ghana will immediately apply an LOC exemption status to all Free Zone companies, effective until further notification.
  - b. Free Zones Companies must apply for the LOC through the ICUMS system, choosing the "Non-Repatriation" option. This selection will automatically confer exemption status to the applicants, streamlining the approval process.
  - c. Should there be any need to revise this exemption status, it will only be done after detailed consultations with all stakeholders.
- We appreciate your prompt attention to these developments.
