The Committee is expected to engage all Party stakeholders and the general public on its terms of reference and submit a comprehensive report to the Party within three (3) months.


The report of the committee shall set the stage for the party's reflection, rebuilding, and restructuring efforts in order to bounce back stronger for the next general elections.
