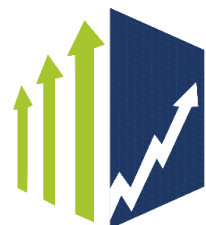


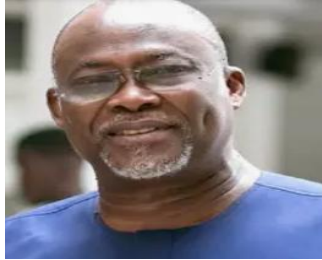
NDC Delegates Poll- Baseline and First Tracking Telephone Poll

13th April 2026

Summary of Findings



- ❑ The first public poll of NDC delegates conducted by Global InfoAnalytics shows the party chairman, Asiedu Nketia takes the lead in the race to replace John Mahama in the 2028 but there are warning signs that his lead could be in danger as the finance minister Ato Forson breath down his neck.
- ❑ Although there are no indications that Ato Forson will contest the race, the polls shows he is the biggest threat to the party chairman’s ambition to lead the party in the 2028 presidential elections.
- ❑ The party chairman, Asiedu Nketia who has been on a nationwide “thank you” tour, leads with 29%, Ato Forson, 19%, Haruna Iddrisu, 11%, Julius Debrah 8%, Prof Jane Naana Opoku-Agyemang, 8%, others, 1% and 24% are undecided.
- ❑ Chairman Asiedu Nketia led Ato Forson by 16 points in the top of the mind (unprompted) baseline poll a week earlier, but that gap shrank to 10 points in a subsequent poll as undecided delegates broke towards the finance minister, Ato Forson.

Summary of Findings

- ❑ Asiedu Nketia also led Haruna Iddrisu by 20 points in the previous poll but now leads by 18 points. In the case of Julius Debrah, Asiedu Nketia led him by 23 points, but that gap has now reduced to 21 points. All the major candidates makes significant gains except the party chairman even as his tour gather pace.
- ❑ In a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Haruna Iddrisu, Asiedu Nketia leads with 42% Haruna Iddrisu, 22% and 36% are undecided.
- ❑ In a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Julius Debrah, Asiedu Nketia leads with 43%, Julius Debrah 18% and 39% undecided. However, in a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Ato Forson, the poll shows much tighter race with Asiedu Nketia leading with 37%, Ato Forson, 32% and 31% are undecided.
- ❑ On the qualities required by delegates in selecting a replacement for John Mahama, the poll shows 74% say performance, 53% say a visionary, 35% say good servant of the government, 20% say good servant of the party, 20% say personality, 8% say youthful candidate, 1% cited gender and 23% other factors.

Summary of Findings

- ❑ The poll also confirms the growing anxiety of the NDC grassroots when it comes to job opportunities as 78% of the delegates are concerned about lack of job opportunities, 13% are not concerned and 9% are neither concerned nor unconcerned.
- ❑ However, 88% of the delegates are hopeful that the situation will improve in the near future, while 3% are not hopeful and nearly 9% don't know whether the situation will improve or not.
- ❑ The poll was conducted between 31st March and 9th April among nearly 10,400 delegates across all the 16 regions using random probability sampling with Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews.

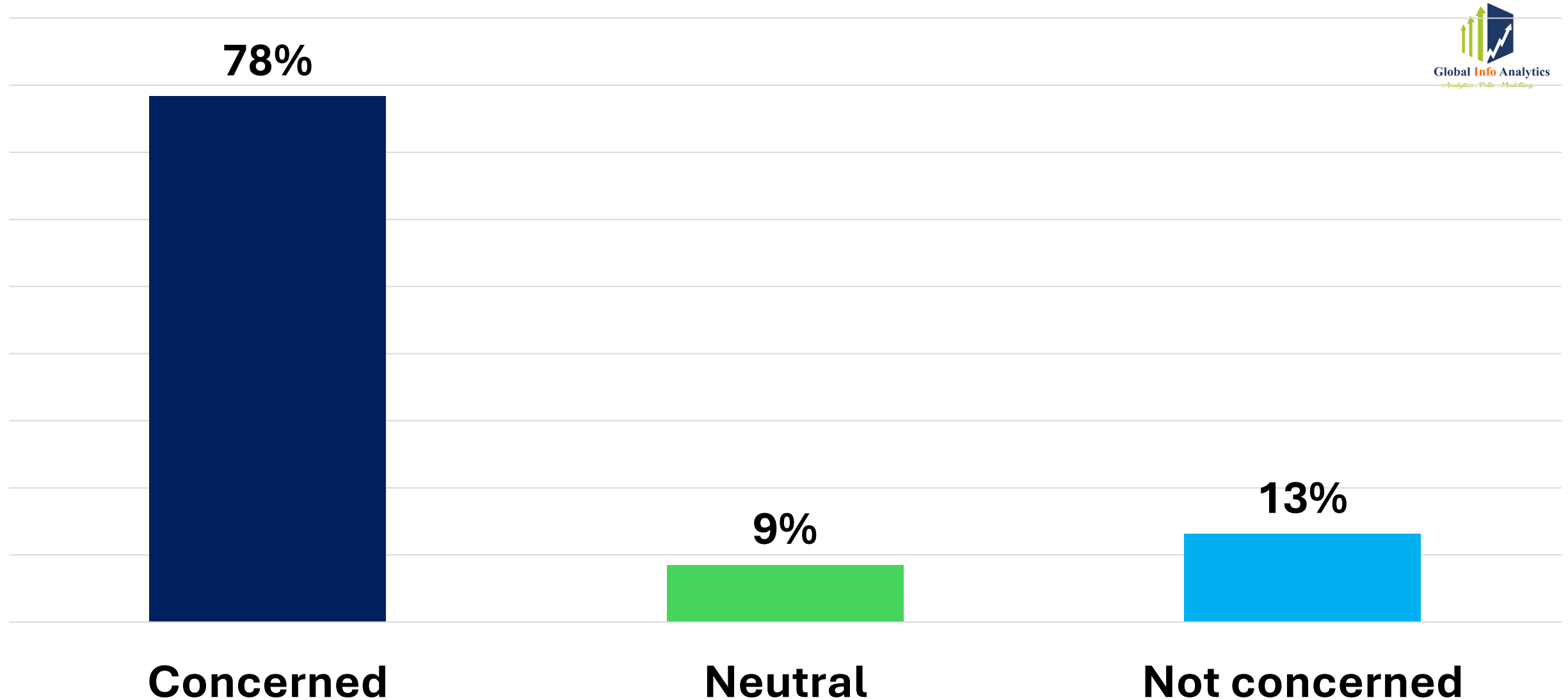

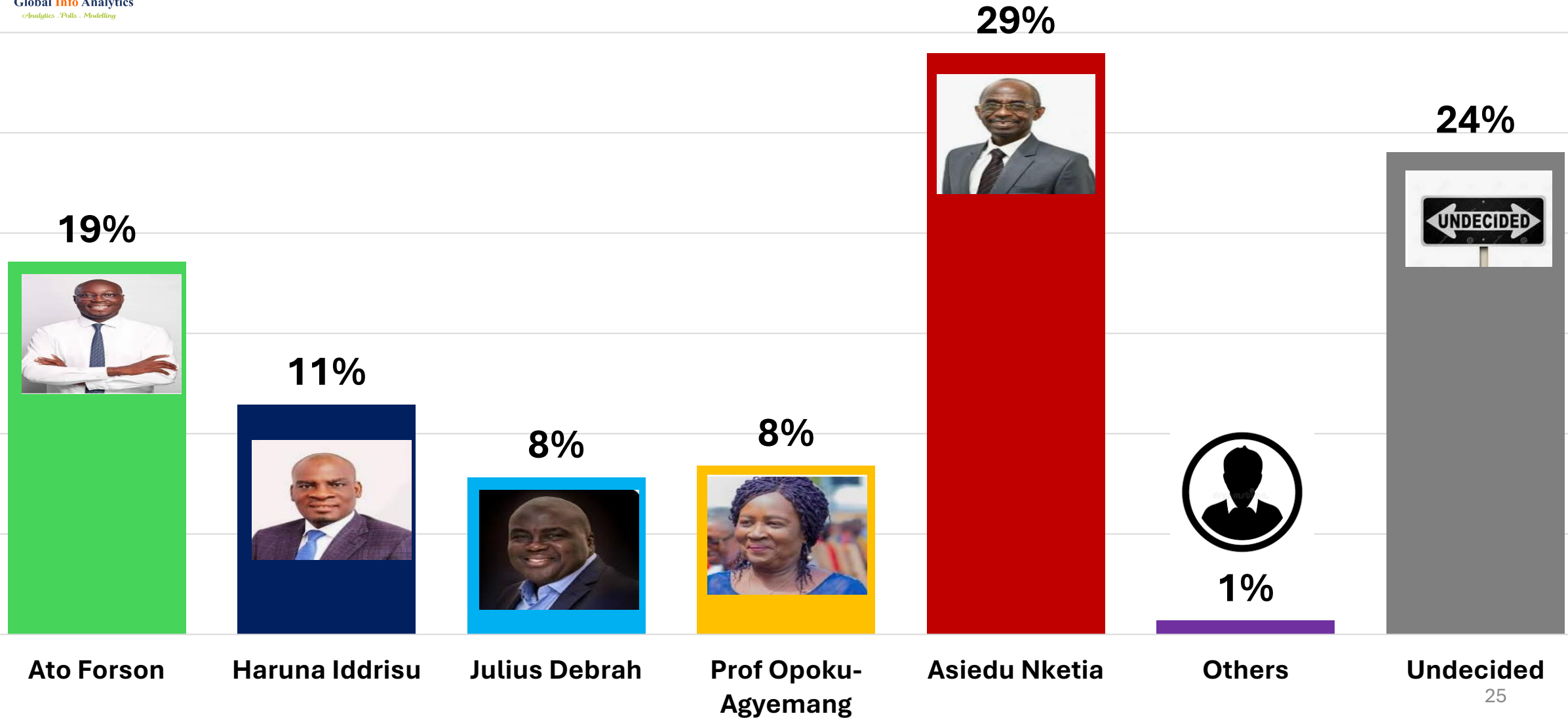

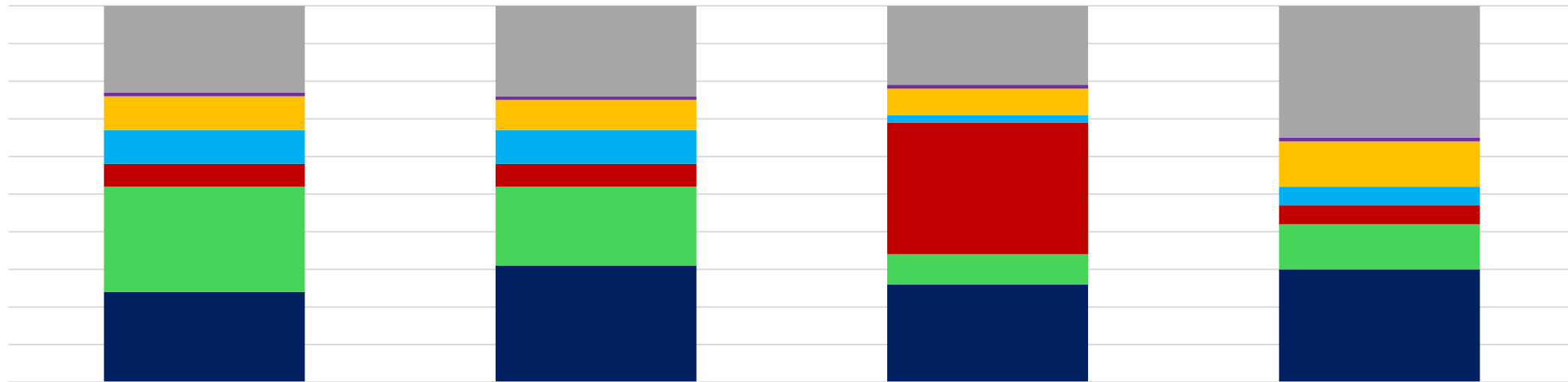

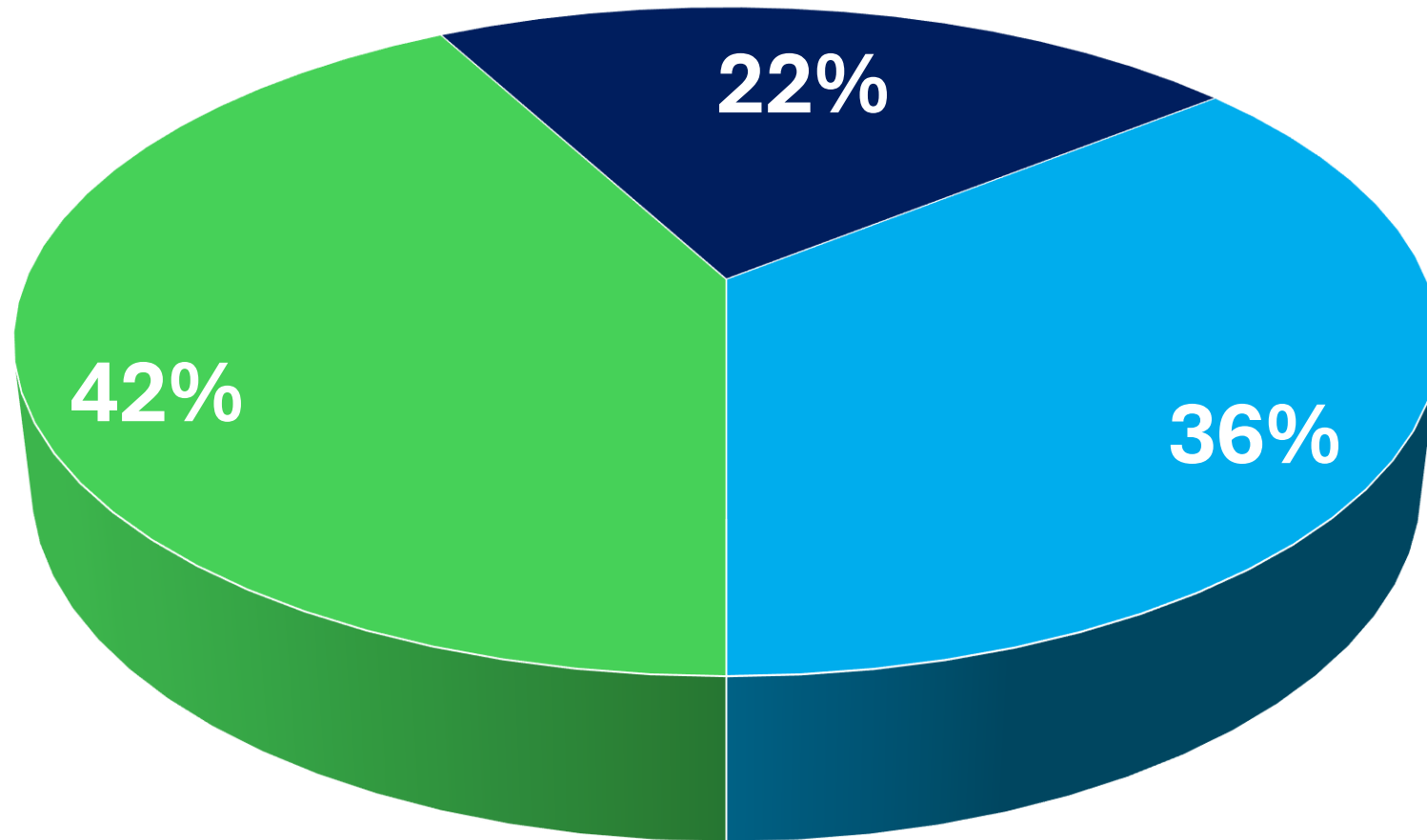

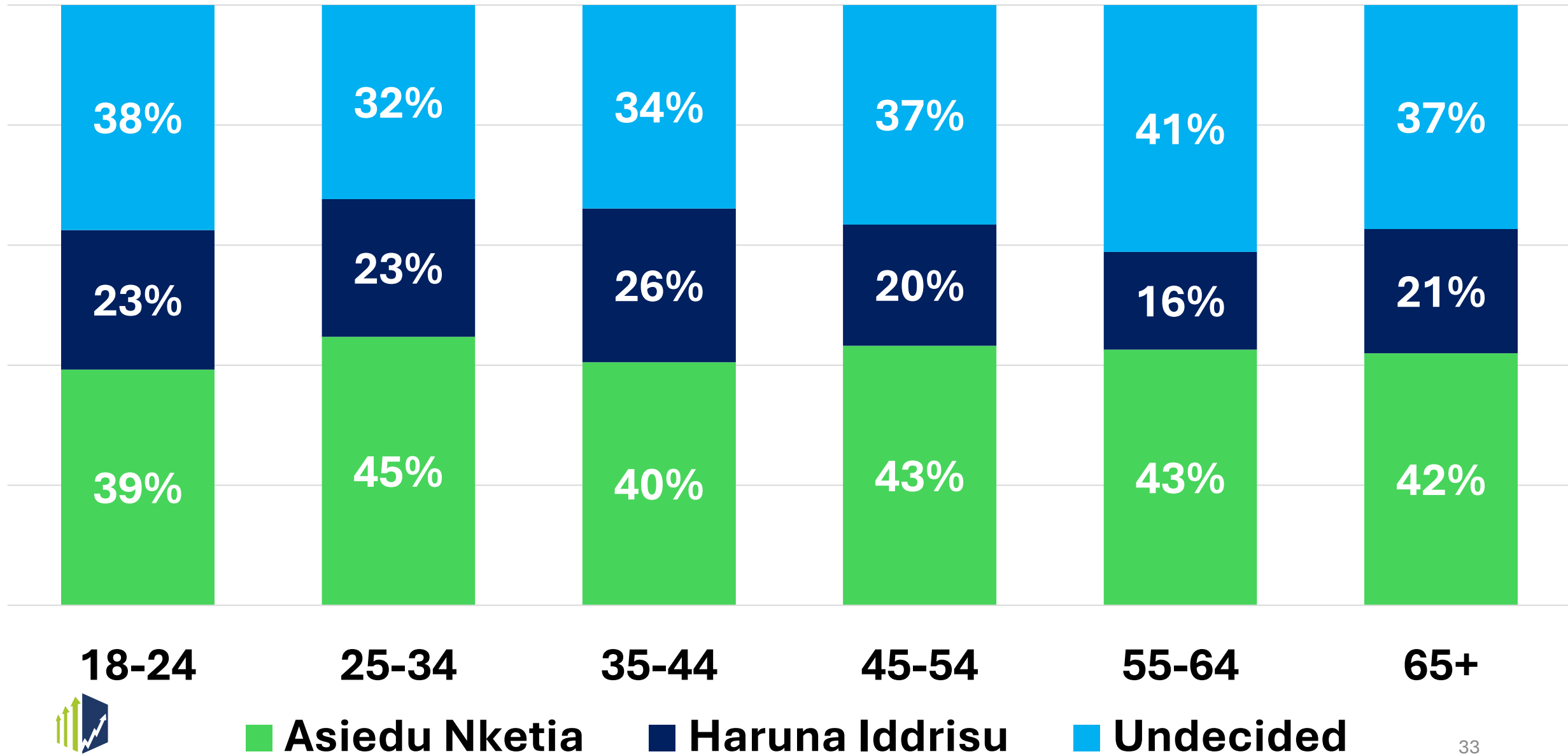

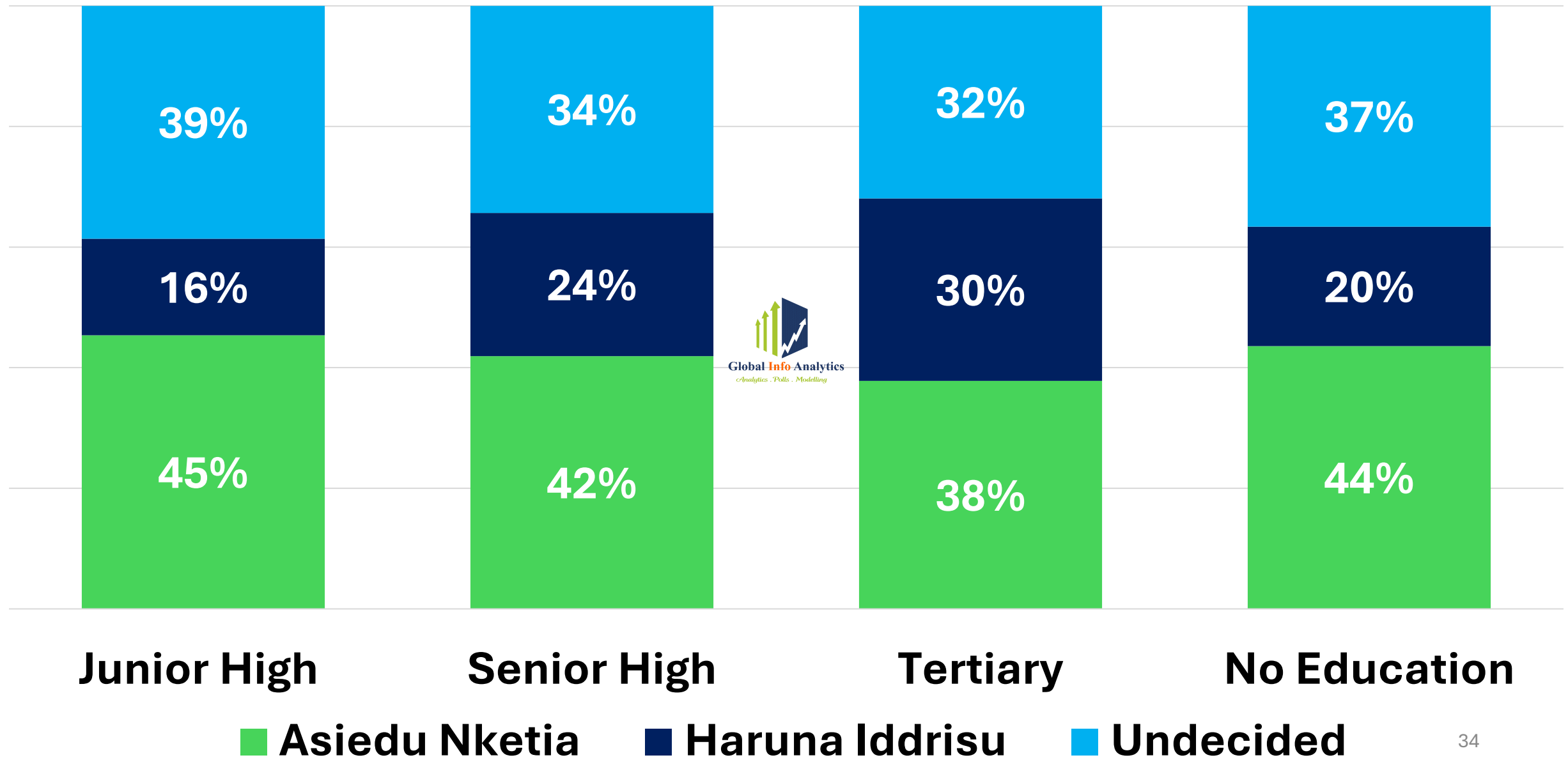

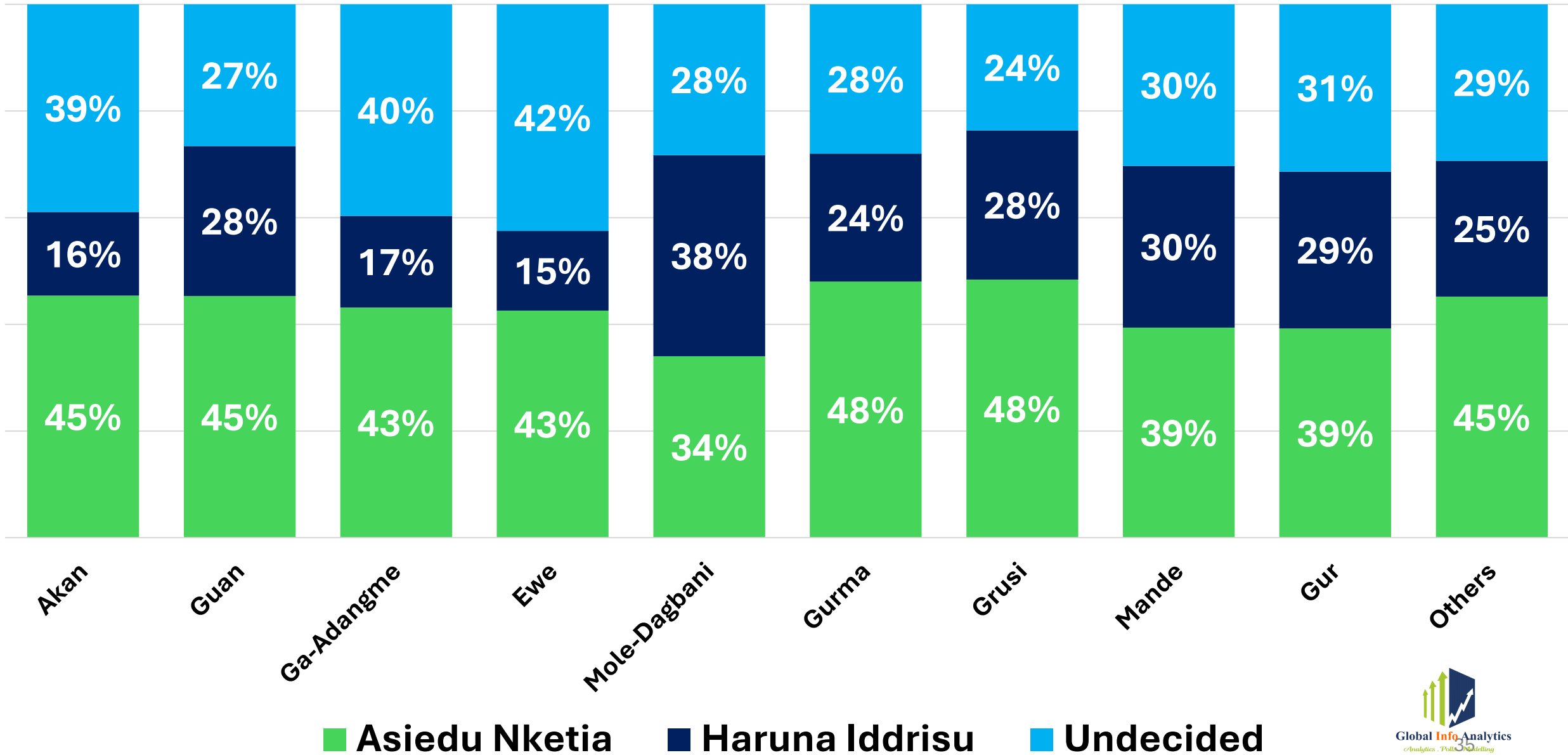
Asiedu Nketia v Haruna Iddrisu – Age Groups

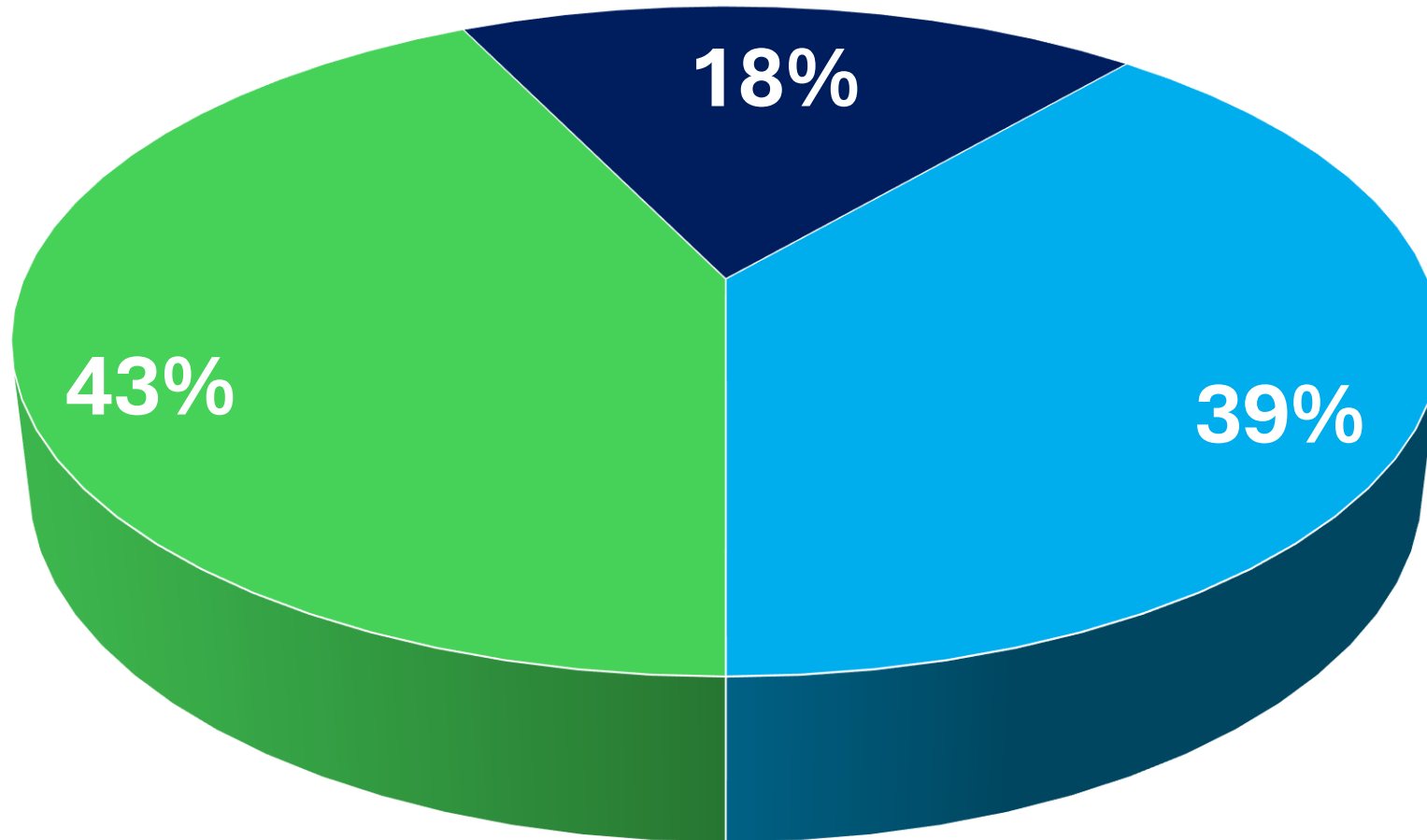

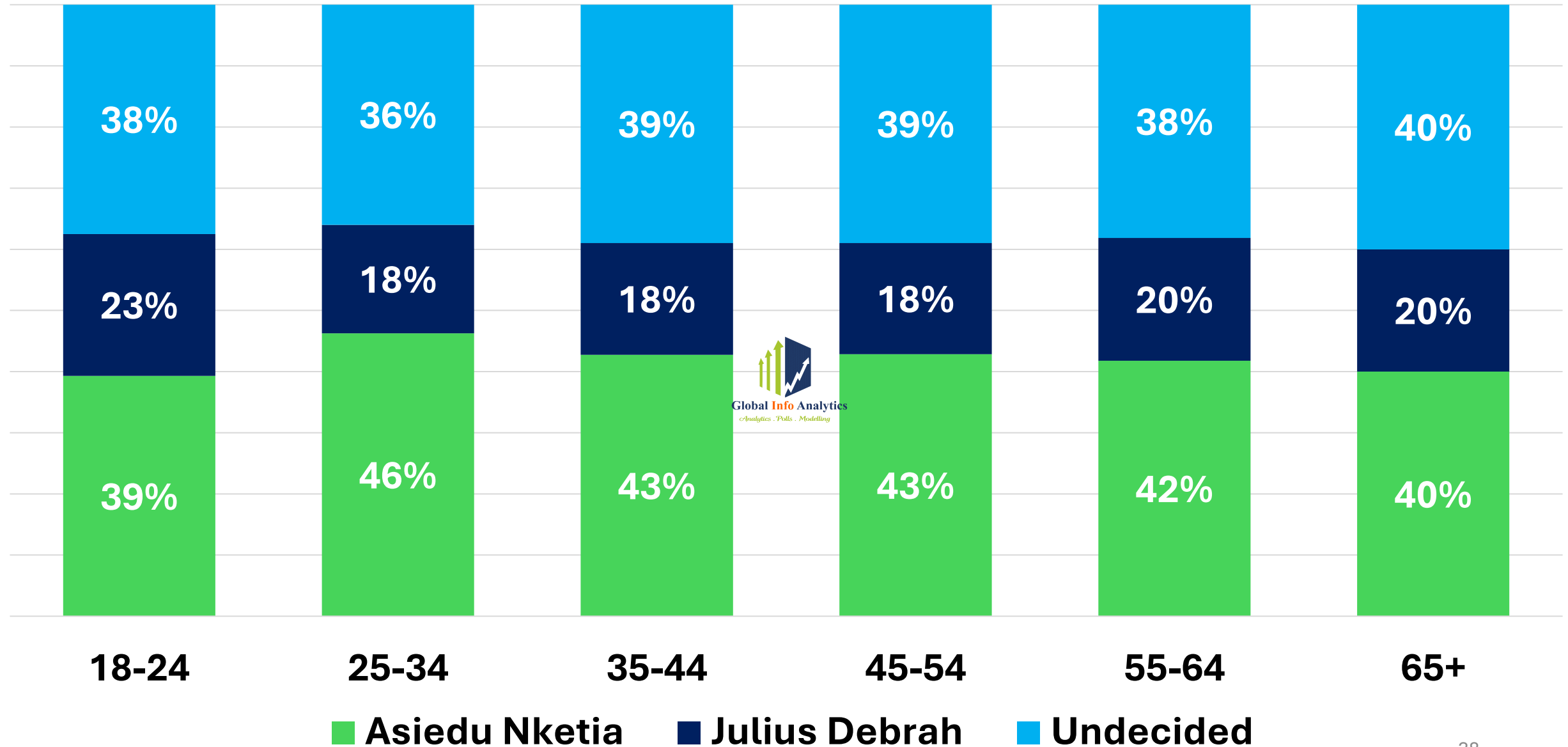

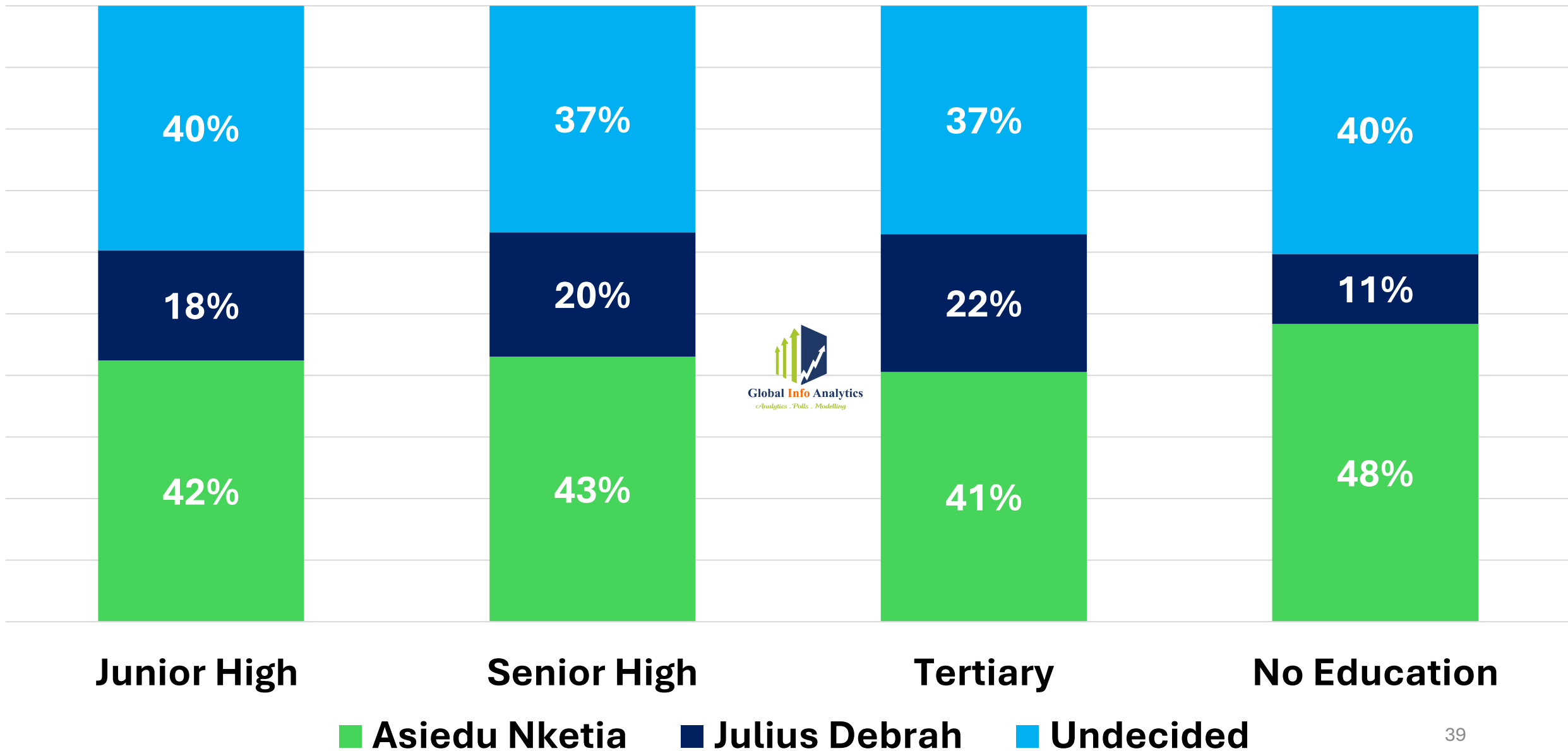

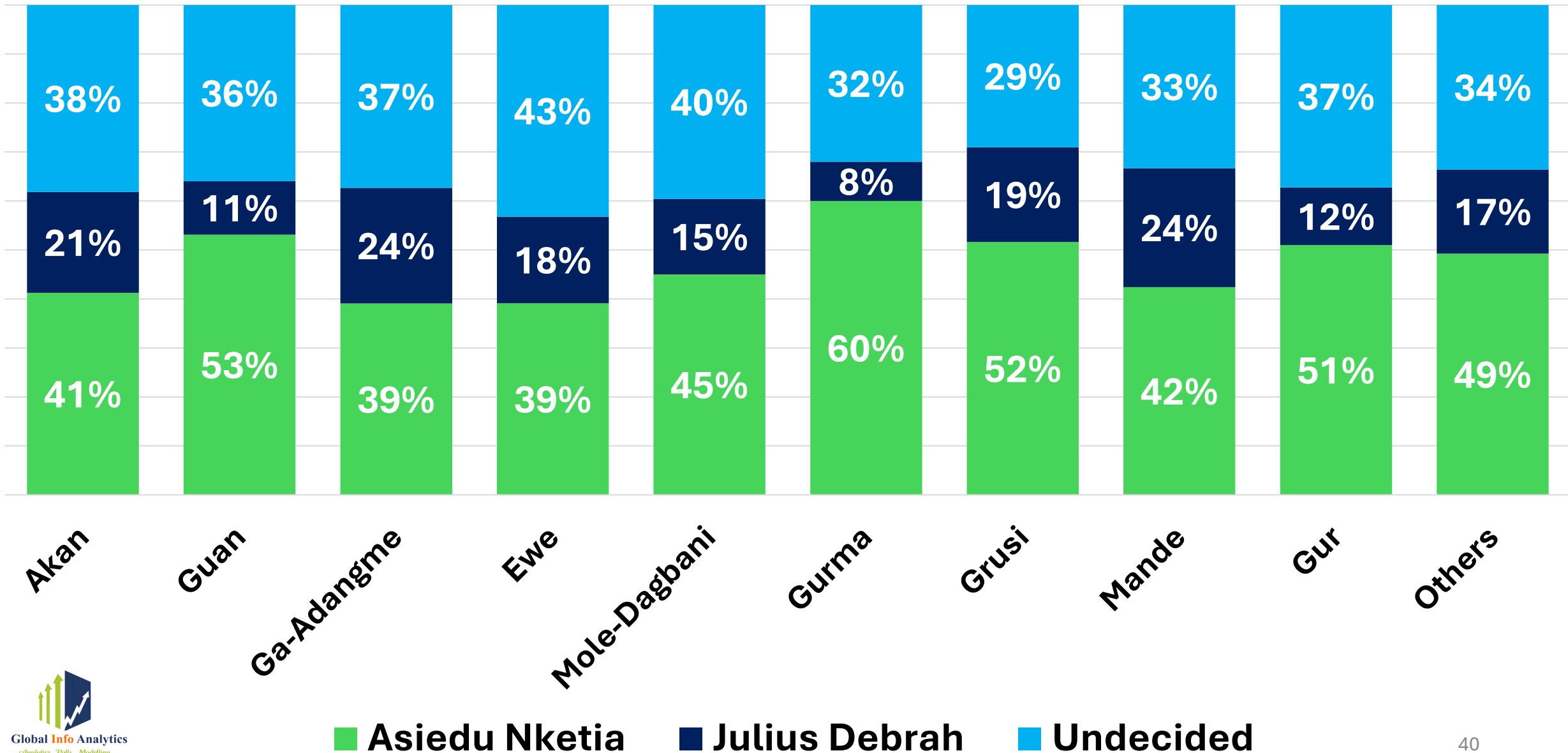
Asiedu Nketia v Julius Debrah-Age Groups

Asiedu Nketia v Ato Forson-Ethnicity

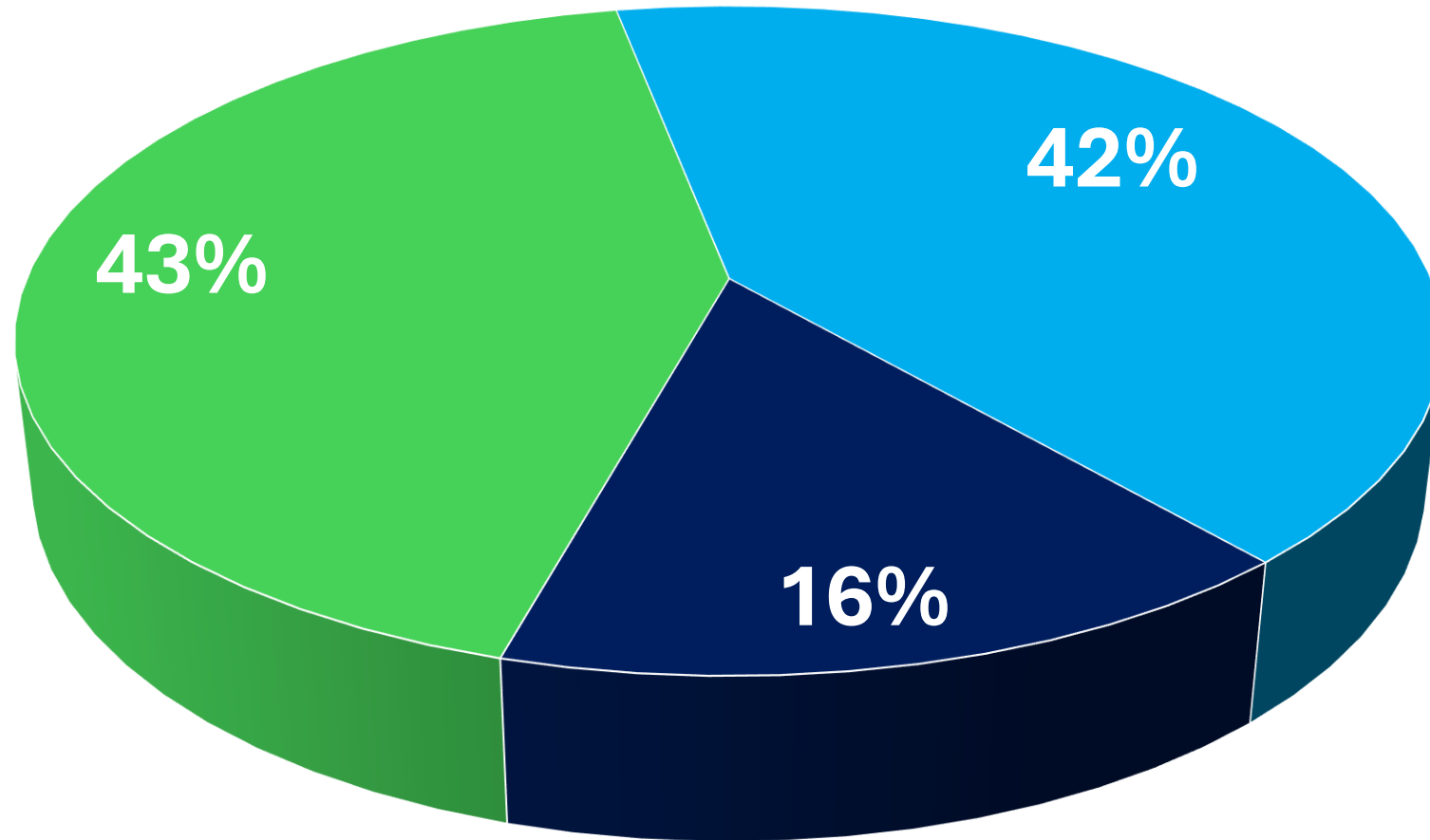

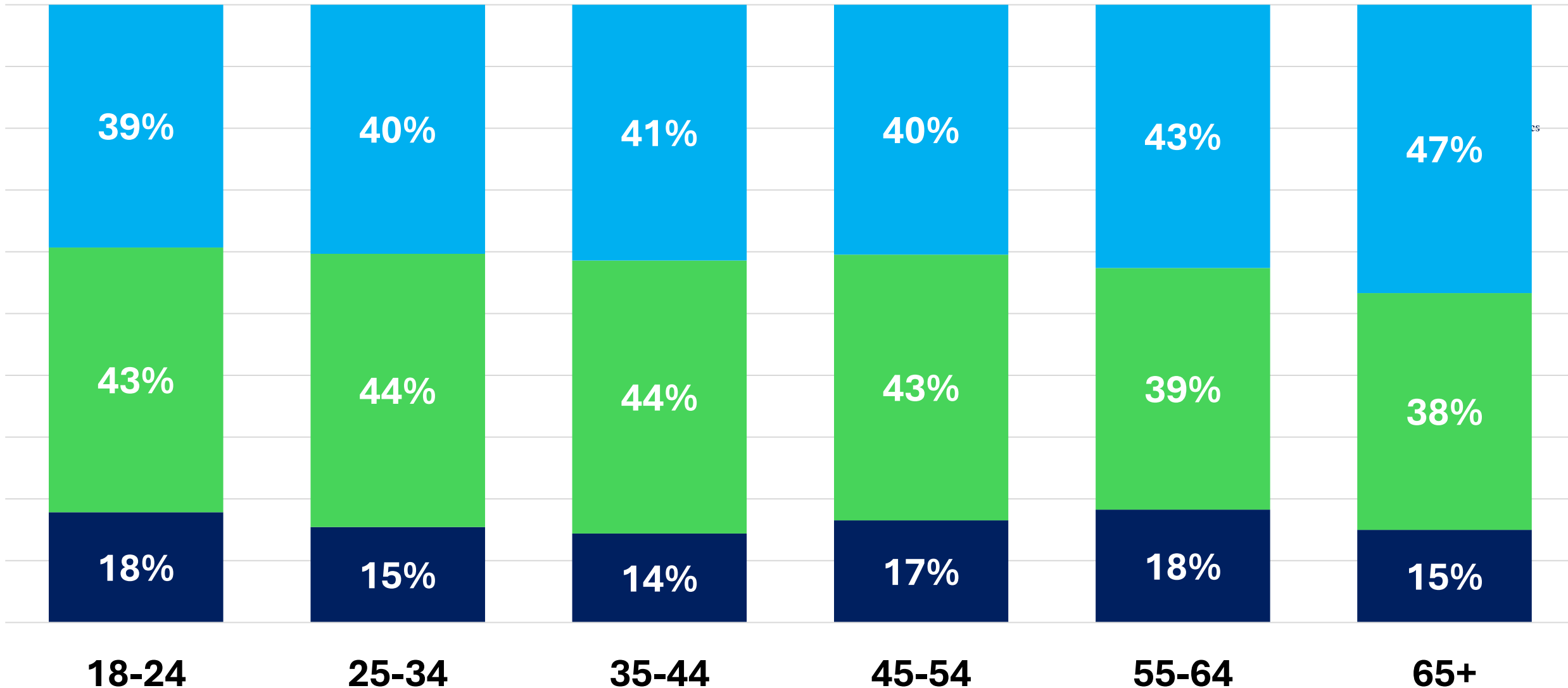

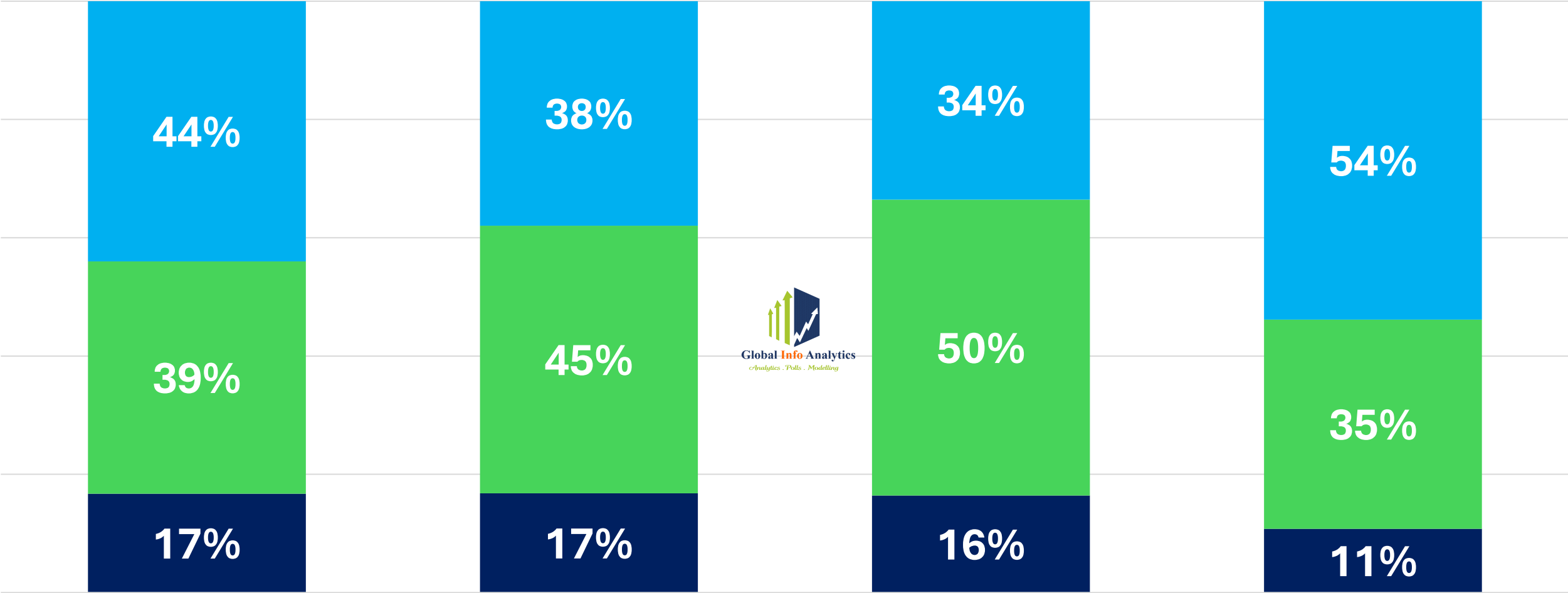

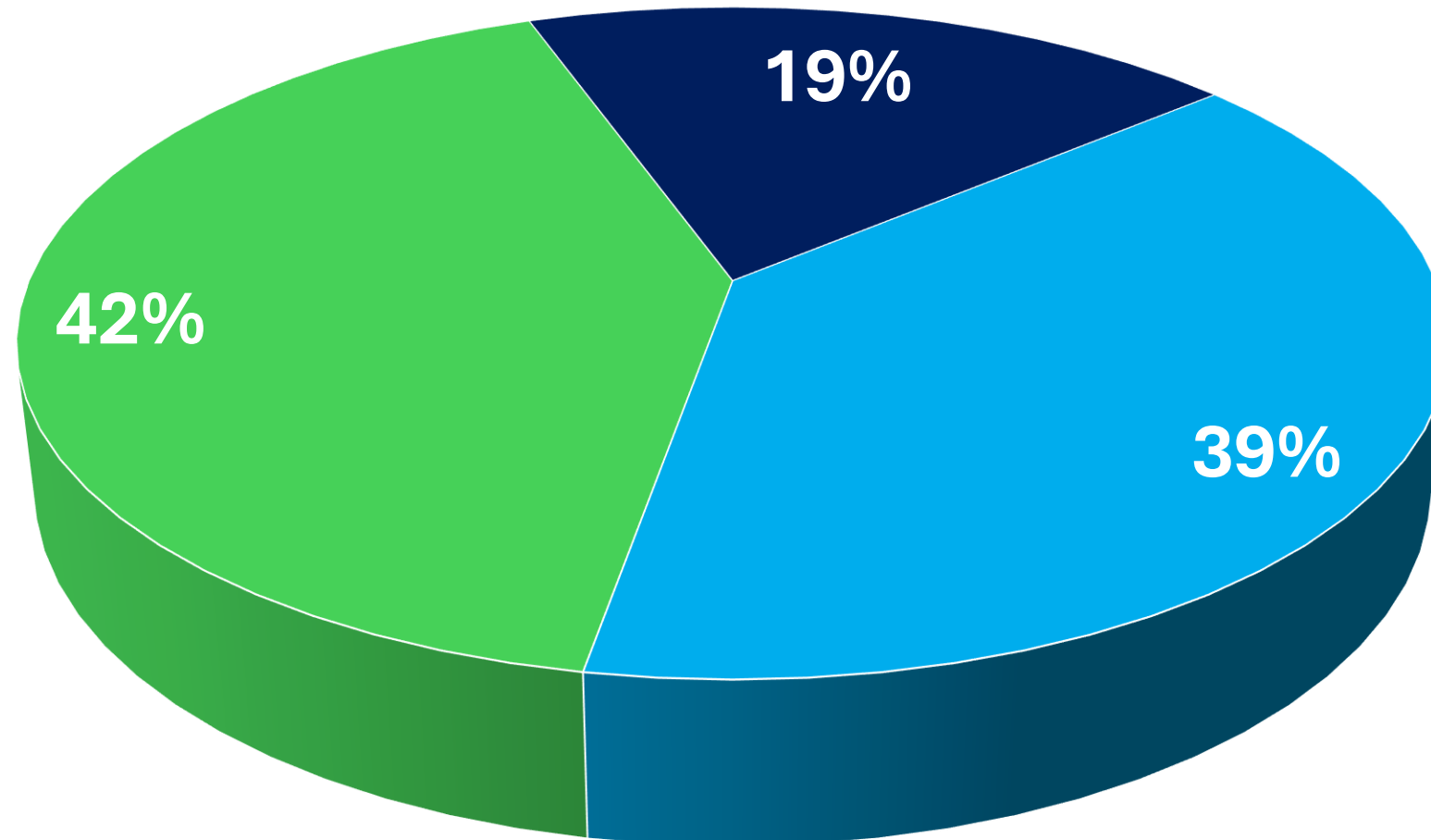

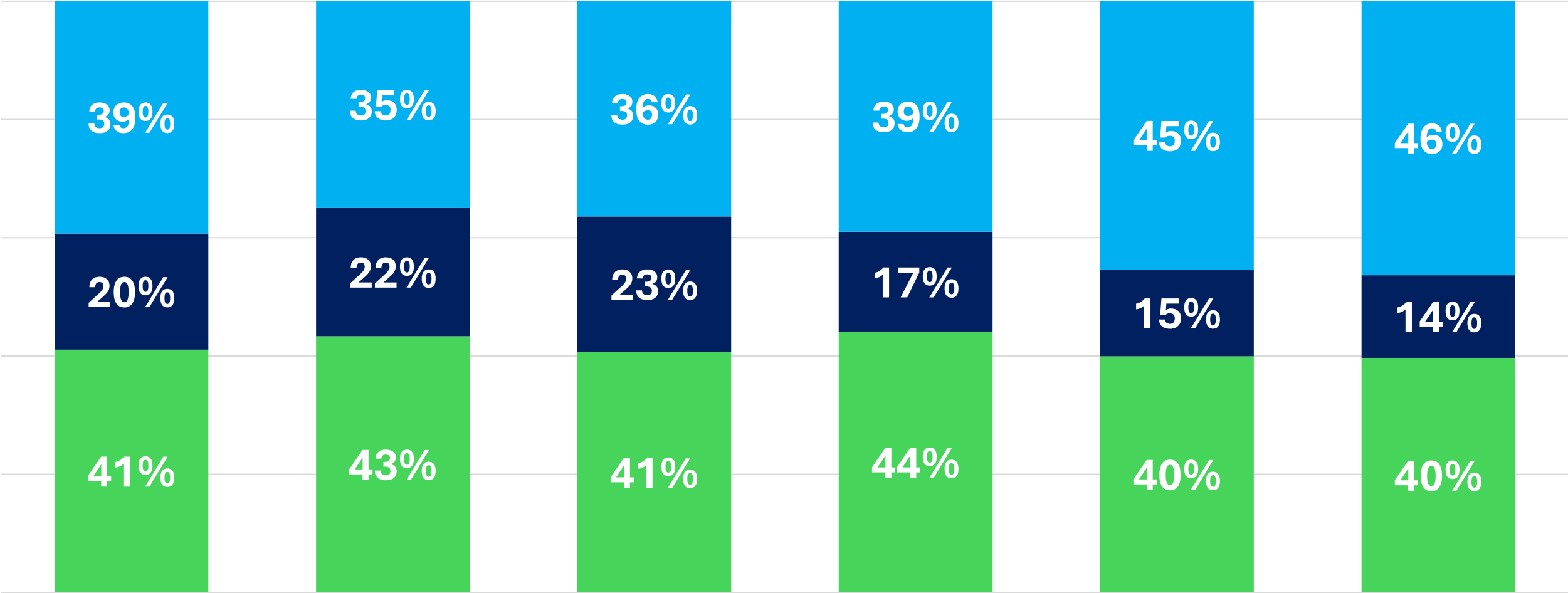

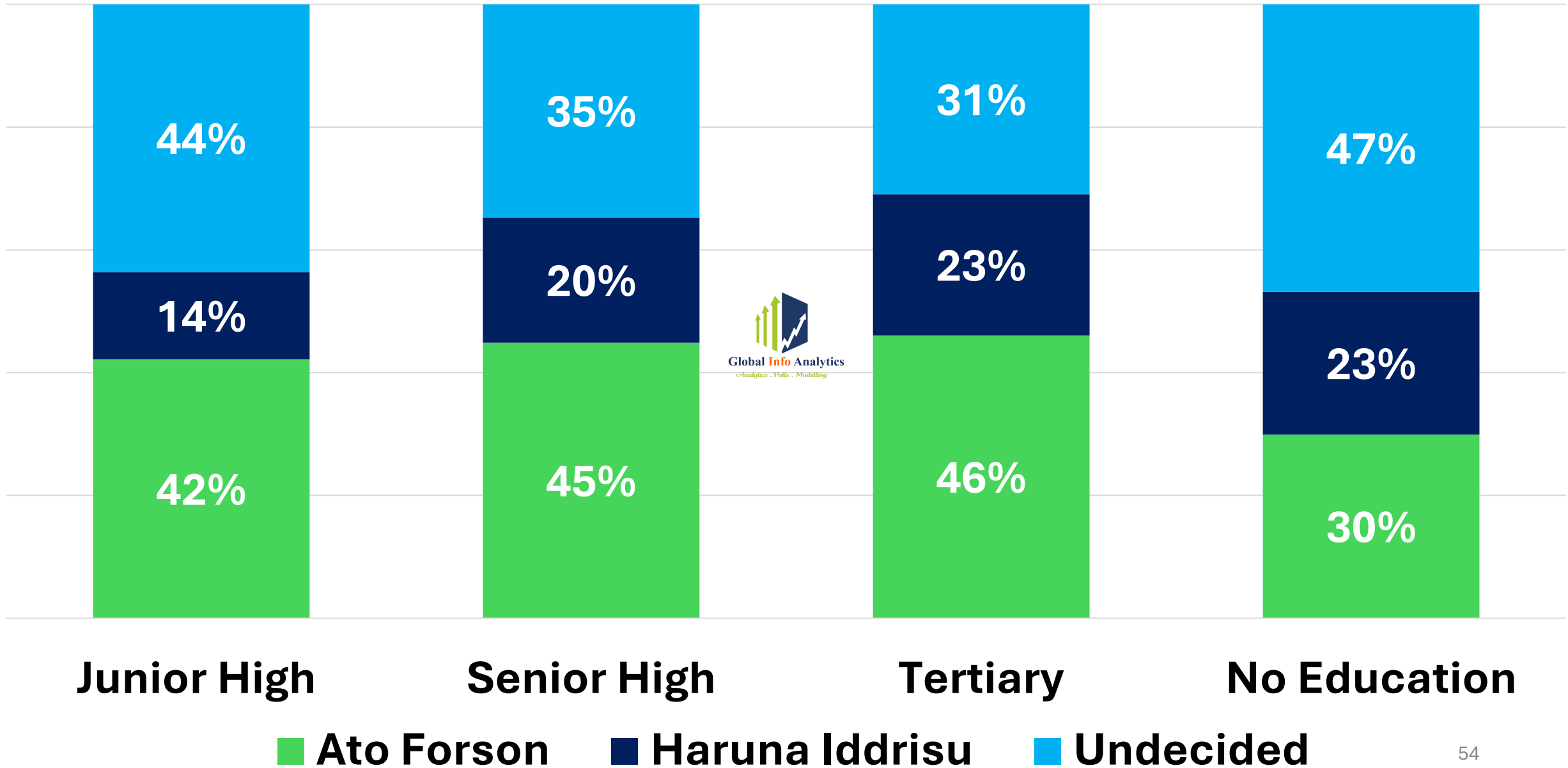
