

PETITION TO THE NATIONAL LEADERSHIP OF THE NEW PATRIOTIC PARTY

SUBJECT: PETITION FOR THE IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION OF HON. KENNEDY OHENE AGYAPONG OVER ANTI-PARTY CONDUCT

I write to formally petition the National Leadership of the New Patriotic Party to take immediate disciplinary action, including suspension, against Hon. Kennedy Ohene Agyapong.

BACKGROUND

In recent weeks, well-meaning Ghanaians, particularly residents of the Ashanti Region, have raised serious concerns over the deteriorating state of healthcare facilities, following challenges at the Komfo Anokye Teaching Hospital (KATH), as well as concerns raised about Suntreso, Atonsu, and Agogo Government Hospitals, among others.

It was against this backdrop that Minority MPs undertook a visit to the Afari Military Hospital to verify the true state of the facility, a visit that regrettably ended in a scuffle with military personnel, drawing widespread public reaction and condemnation.

In the aftermath, Hon. Kennedy Ohene Agyapong came out publicly to criticise the Minority's visit, peddling claims that have since been shown to be unjustified and at odds with the true situation at the hospital.

GROUNDS FOR THIS PETITION

1. Why would Hon. Agyapong peddle falsehoods against his own party's Minority caucus, rather than support a genuine effort to hold government accountable on a matter of public health concern?
2. Hon. Agyapong has, in his own media interview, revealed that he was approached by persons linked to the current NDC administration with a \$65 million contract for himself and his wife, with an 11% kickback being demanded. The public deserves to know: on what basis would the NDC approach a sitting member of the opposition with such a contract, if not for some existing relationship or understanding?
3. Is it this same relationship that explains why Hon. Agyapong has chosen to defend the NDC's interests and attack his own party's Minority over a legitimate visit undertaken in the public interest?
4. Why have the Minority Leader, Hon. Alexander Afenyo-Markin, and the General Secretary, Mr. Justin Kodua Frimpong, remained silent and failed to publicly condemn this clear act of anti-party conduct?

DEMAND

I am calling on the National Leadership to immediately bring disciplinary action against Hon. Kennedy Ohene Agyapong for his anti-party conduct.

Should the party fail to act, I, together with other identifiable groups and well-meaning members of this party, will not sit by quietly. We will speak out, loudly and unapologetically, until the right thing is done.
